CHERYL TROSTRUD-WHITE is originally from Chicago, Illinois, lived in the Los Angeles area from 1985 through 2005, now lives in Santa Fe, New Mexico. She taught elementary school art for fourteen years. She constructs quilts and quilted clothing. Over the last twenty-three years, her designs have varied in their exploration of themes: from traditional to contemporary. She was asked to design garments for eight Fairfield-Concord Fashion shows, including the Tenth, Fifteenth, Twentieth Anniversary shows and the Twenty-second and final show in 2000. She was invited to judge the first Bernina Show in 2001 and create a garment for the 2002 show. In 1991, she founded the "Wearable Art Connection," a Southern California network that now has over 400 fiber artists. Besides teaching and lecturing both in the United States and abroad, including a lecture trip to Tokyo and Osaka, Japan, Cheryl has exhibited across the country in quilt and wearable competitions, receiving awards from the AIQA show, the AQS show and the NQA show. Her work has been on exhibit at the Nihon Vogue Quilt Salon in Tokyo, Japan, the Dairy Barn in Athens, Ohio, the American Quilter's Society Museum in Paducah, Kentucky, and

Cheryl's garments and quilts have appeared on Sew Creative, the Home Show and Simply Quilts. Cheryl was recently featured in a segment on Sew Much More, HG-TV.
