June 23rd we will have Michael Meyer of Santa Fe as our guest speaker and teacher. Her lecture is titled "Out of the Matrix". Her workshop is also "Out of the Matrix" and covers fabric inlay, appliqué and assemblage techniques. Her work will be hanging in the Mesa Public Library in Los Alamos in June with an opening set for Saturday June 6th

Vice-President update:


