Quilt Frames

The guild has three metal, adjustable quilt frames. Well, actually they are used to hold paper backdrops for photography. Some of our quilts are too heavy for the frames and they can fall. Sometimes the quilts become sails if it's windy and then they fall.

Parts have been purchased and installed so that all three frames are usable again. No. 1 and 2 are great. No. 3 is partially usable in that it has a height limit due to a stuck pole, so it can be used for shorter quilts. I suggest that No. 3 can be used for parts if something happens to the other two. Please remember that the brackets are plastic. If the screws are screwed too tight, the plastic will break and the frame is not usable. The frames are marked so you can tell which is which. Be kind to them and they will last a long time. Micki

Mystery Quilt Directions

Mystery Quilt 2010

<u>Step 3</u> – From medium fabric, cut four 2 ½ by 42 inch strips. Cut a 30 ½ inch strip from each. Label and set aside. From the remainder cut twenty 2 ½ inch squares.

From the BG fabric cut two 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch strips. Cut them all into 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares. Set aside all but 25 of the BG squares.

(Doing it the old-fashioned way,) sew squares together to make five nine-patch blocks with the BG fabric making the X.

BG/M/BG

M/BG/M

BG/M/BG.

Do not sew 9 patches together.

Keep all extra squares and fabric.


