Show and Tell — Donna showed a star quilt she had made for her sister. Roberta showed a QOV quilt she had made. Tricia showed an art piece she made. Laura showed an I Spy and an auction quilt.

The program was our own – Nicole Dunn. Nicole, a member of SAQA, brought many quilts she had made and a few she had acquired. She showed several wool projects. Animals and birds, a block of the month and other projects she had worked on from the Wool and Coffee group that meets at Film Festival on Friday mornings.

She showed quilts made from panels. She liked working with panels because the quilts go together quickly.

Nicole dyes fabric and showed quilts she had made with the hand dyed fabric.

She explained very often her quilts were influenced by her life activities. She had quilts inspired by her birthday, and vacations. She showed antique quilts that she had bought or tops she had bought and quilted.

There were series of quilts that she had made—several weave quilts and several New York beauty quilts made in different colors and designs.

She also showed quilts made by friends, groups and professional quilters. There were many, many examples to think about and work into our projects, along with the information needed to make those quilts.

The next meeting will be a Sew-a-Thon on March 26th at the White Rock Presbyterian Church.
